Manuscript language – English (American or British)

The target length for a manuscript is 3,000 - 10,000 words.

- References to publications within the text should be as follows: (Zsizsek, 2002: 26), (Encyclopaedia of Philosophy, 1983: 220), (Zsizsek, 2008a: 26), (Zsizsek, 2008b: 75).
- There must be a strict one-to-one correspondence between the names and years in the text and those in the list of references.
- Footnotes should be kept to a minimum and indicated by consecutive superscript numbers.
- The abstract should also contain a short list of carefully chosen Keywords or content indicators (5-10 words).
- Submitted papers must be clearly written in English. The mixture of American and British usage of English is not allowed, whereas both usages of English are accepted.

The Editorial Board recommends using the [manuscript template](#)
